


From the Mass of the Holy Trinity, June 4, 2023






After Jesus died and rose again, Christians remembered what he said and tried to put his words into practice.




Many people were amazed to see how happy they were to be together. They were struck by the way they encouraged each other and helped one another to understand how to live in unity and peace.
