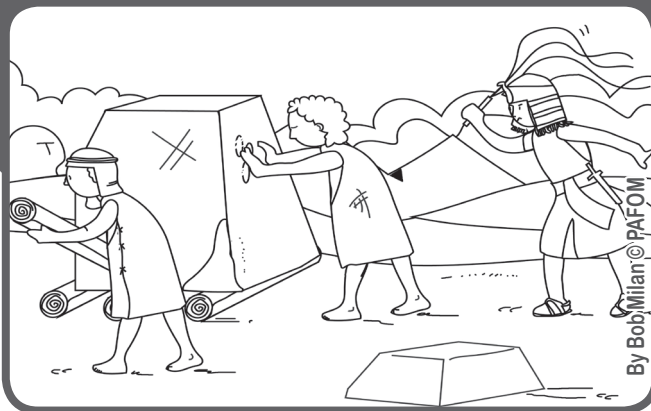

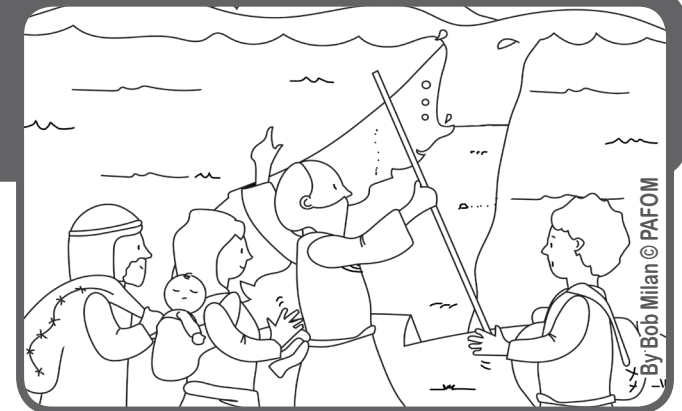

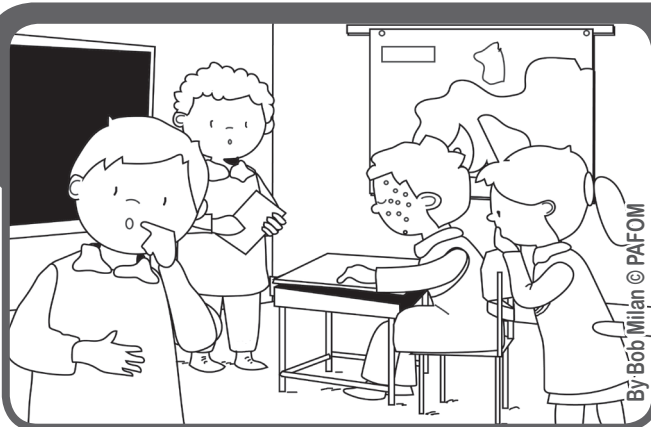
The Hebrews lived through many difficult moments, like when they had to leave their country and live in a foreign land far away.



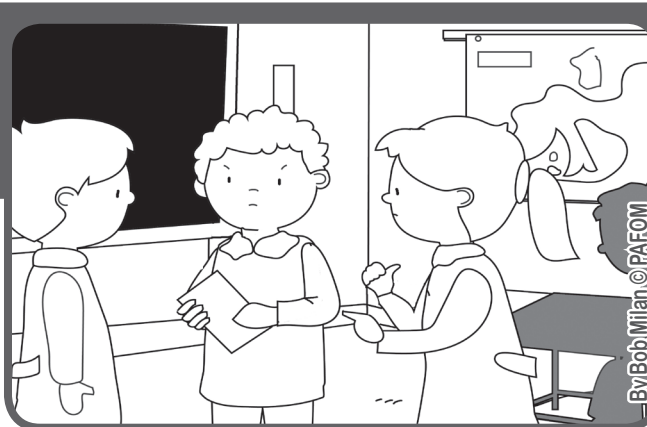
During those years that were so sad and full of hardships, they felt that God never left them alone.



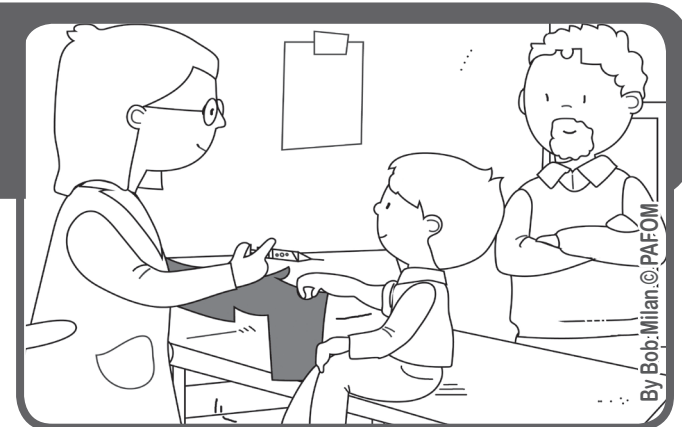
He helped them know what to do, he protected them and he always brought them to freedom. We trust God, too. His love for us is like the sun that never sets.
