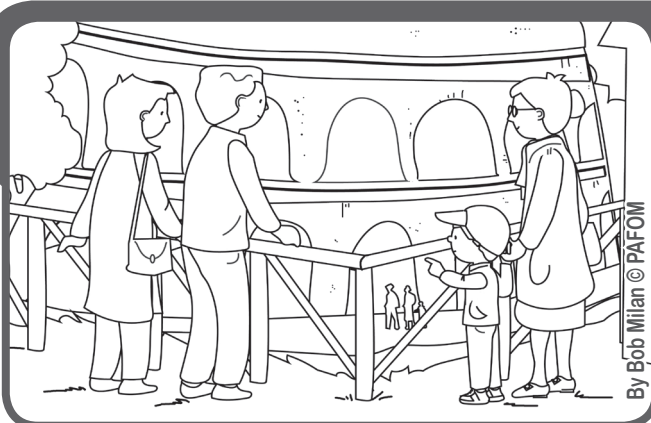
After travelling a lot, Paul finally arrived in Rome. The trip had been very difficult. He was starving, wounded and had to run away from people who wanted to kill him.



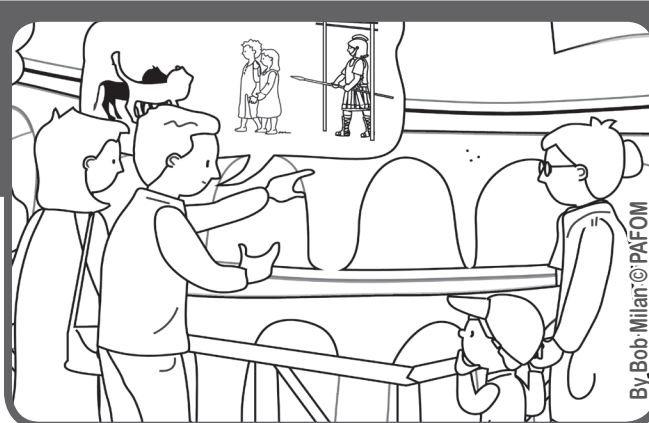
He was at the end of his life, but he told everyone that God never left him alone.



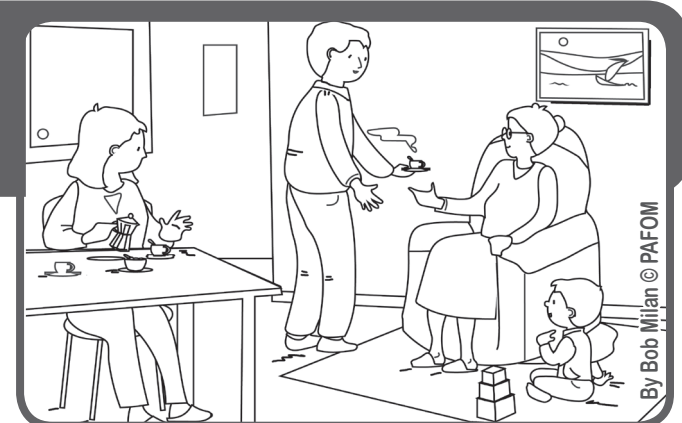
He wrote to the Christians who lived in Rome, "When we trust in God's love, we are victorious!"
