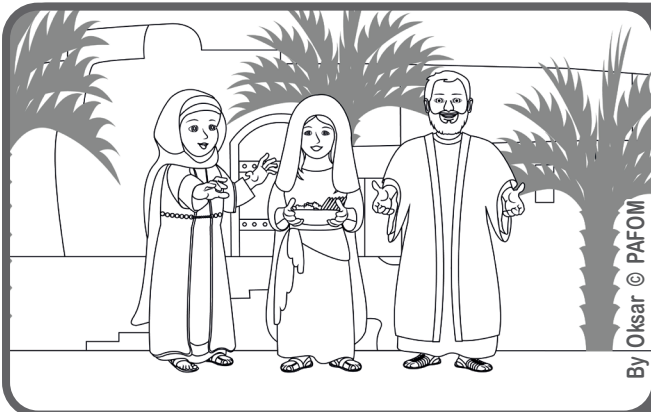

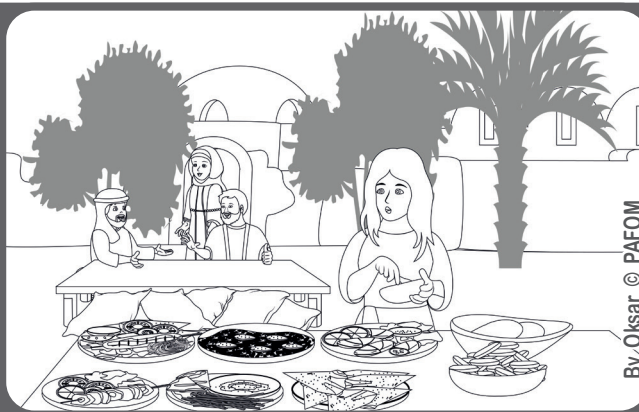

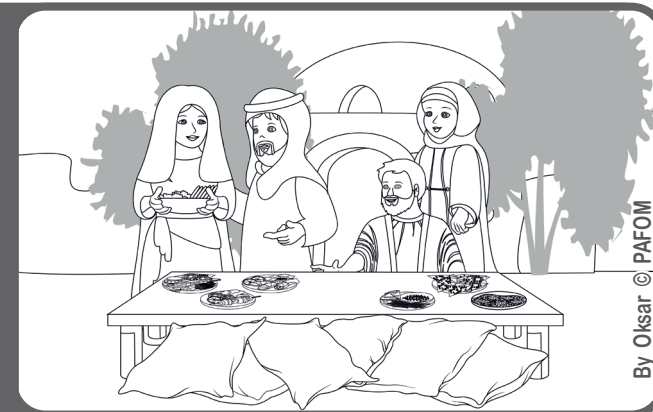

Jesus had many friends and among them were Martha, Mary and Lazarus who lived in Bethany.



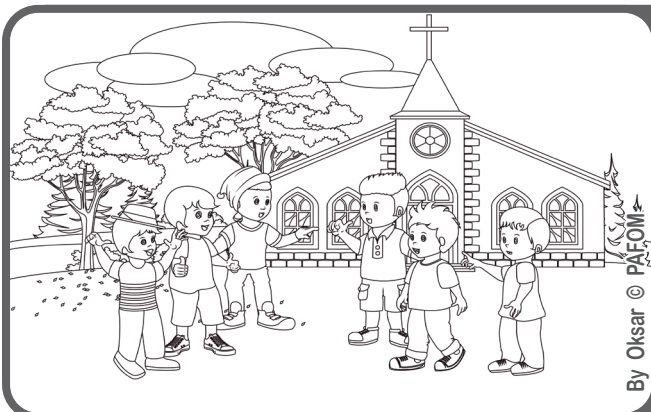

One day Jesus was visiting their home. Martha was cleaning the house and then she prepared a good meal for Jesus. Mary instead stopped working to listen to Jesus.



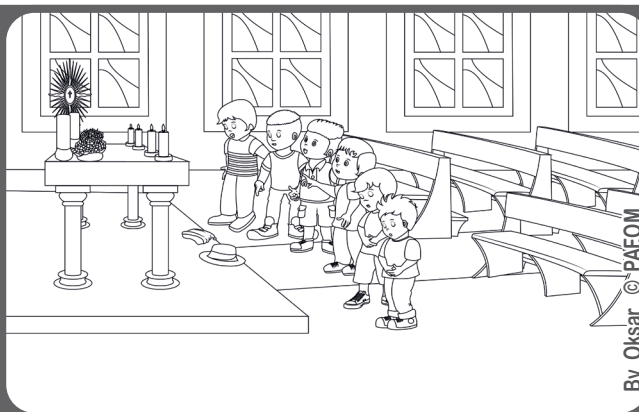

Martha was a little bit upset about this because she wanted Mary to help her but Jesus explained to her that it's also important to listen to the voice of God when he speaks to us.



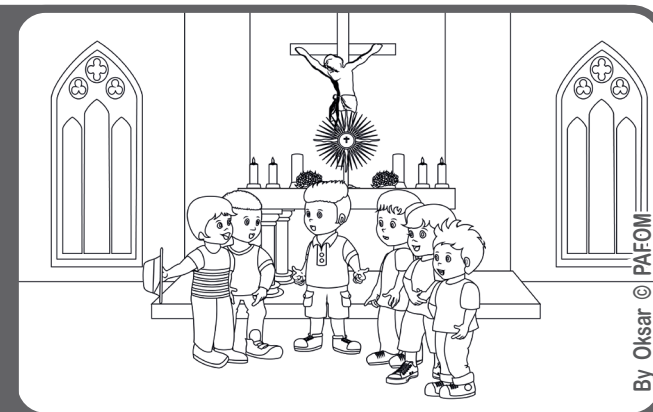
