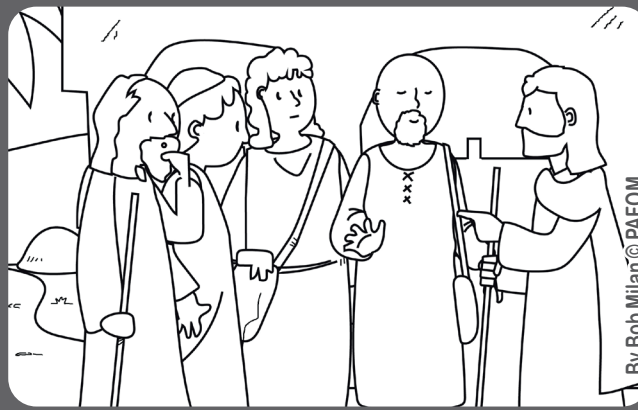

“Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all.” (Mk 9:35)



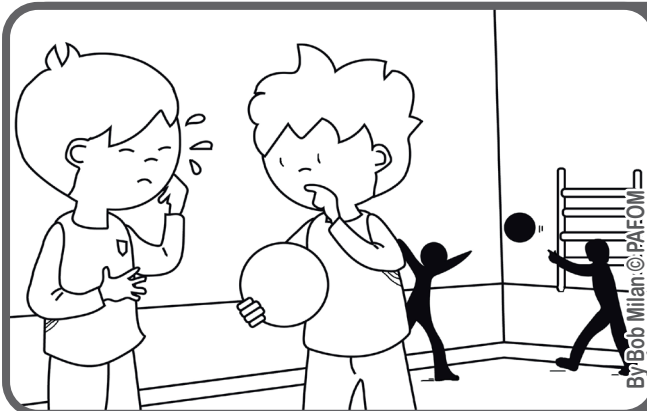
As they were walking to Capernaum, the disciples were arguing about something and Jesus heard them.



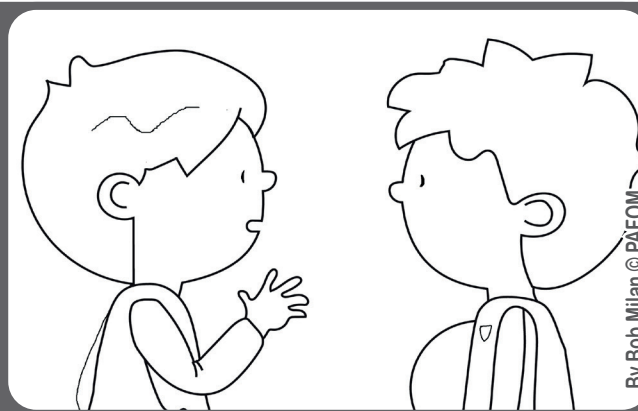
When they got there, Jesus asked them: “What were you talking about?” They were ashamed and didn’t answer. In fact, they had been discussing which of them was the greatest and the best.



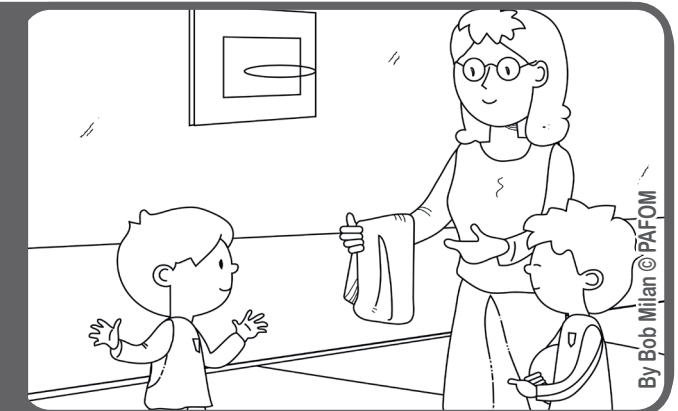
So Jesus had them sit down and told them, “Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all.”
