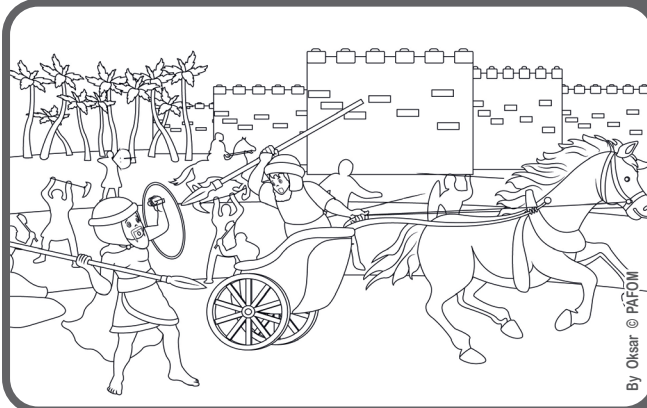

In the Bible, the prophet Isaiah reminded the people that God invites all of us to take care of one another, especially those who are in great need.



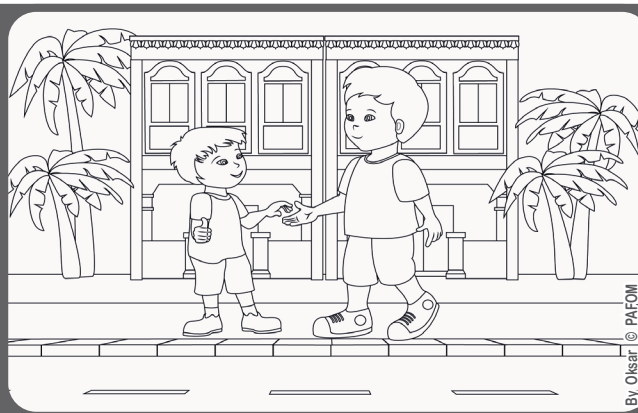
